

The Epps Scholarship Fund

Description: The Epps Scholarship Fund awards scholarships to college-bound high school seniors based on demonstrated academic achievement, financial need, and an express interest in pursuing a legal education.

Eligibility: The students eligible for assistance must be graduating high school seniors who reside in Missouri and intend to continue their education at a four-year college or university and then at an accredited law school. Consideration will be given to academic achievement, financial need and the student's community service record. Students should submit a scholarship application on the form provided by the Greater Kansas City Community Foundation.

Amount: Each scholarship awarded will be a minimum of \$2,000 annually to be paid in two equal installments.

Deadline: May 1, 2010.

Scholarships awarded in 2009: Two.
